Aims

- To elaborate a study unit offered for 3rd year pharmacy students on pharmaceutical analysis which includes a toxicology perspective
- To focus unit on toxicology and on the analysis of drugs from biological fluids
- To attain student feedback about the developed course



Methodology

Topics covered:

- Measuring toxicity
- Exposure and effects of toxic substances
- Biotranformation
- Mutagenesis, carcinogenesis and teratogenesis
- Treatment
- Drugs of abuse
- Drug testing



Methodology

- Students were asked to rate the course
- 29 questions- divided into 6 sections:
- (i) General questions
- (ii) Study-unit description and delivery
- (iii) Lecturing methodology
- (iv) Lecturer
- (v) Method of assessment
- (vi) Administration and resources



Results

For the topics covered:

- General overview of topic
- Clinical and pharmacological relevance
- Importance of any related bioanalysis
- Quiz and case studies
