The President gave a brief account of the EAFP activities for the past year. He introduced the Regional Officers, the Scientific Programme Developer, the Publications Liaison Officer and the Newsletter Editor. He gave an overview of the collaboration with other partners namely FIP-AIMS Forum, PGEU, EAHP, EIPG, EPSA and GAPE.

The President and the General Secretary presented the new EAFP website available at www.eafponline.eu which was intended to increase visibility of the Association and promote networking amongst members.
