In a few days we will meet together at our *Alma Mater*. We are very much looking forward to your visit to the Jagiellonian University and generally speaking to Krakow.

Here is some useful information.

We invite all interested in the pre-conference workshop "Virtual clinical trials and virtual twin approach for the drug pharmacokinetics and cardiac safety assessment" to the Auditorium Maximum (Krupnicza str. 17, 2nd floor Exhibition Hall) on Wednesday (May 15th) at 9.30 a.m.

The conference venue on Wednesday will be the Main Assemble Hall of Collegium Novum of the Jagiellonian University (Gołębia str.24). We will start at 2 p.m. The registration desks will be open from 12.30 p.m. in front of Main Assemble Hall and from 8 a.m. on the following days in the Auditorium Maximum.

On Wednesday, the Welcome Reception will take place in the Museum of the Pharmacy located in the city center (Floriańska str. 25), 10-15 min. walking distance from Collegium Novum.

On the second and third day (May 16th, 17th) the conference will be held in the Auditorium Maximum of the Jagiellonian University (Krupnicza str.17) in medium lecture hall.

On Thursday May16th at 6 p.m., a visit to the Wieliczka Salt Mine, a world class monument inscribed in the UNESCO World Cultural and Natural Heritage List, will be organized. At 8 p.m. the gala dinner will be held also in the salt mine in Jana Haluszki Chamber. We will provide bus transport to the Wieliczka Salt Mine. The departure of buses is scheduled for 5.15 p.m. from the Auditorium Maximum. You should take into account that the temperature in the mine is stable and ranges between 14 and 16°C. A part of the route in salt main leads along stairs, so it is a good idea to wear comfortable shoes.
