





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Evolution of Pharmacy practice


- Shift in focus:





- Plan to start offering Pharm.D. program in 2014
- 5-year plan to train clinical pharmacy faculty and preceptors
- Systemically training program for clinical pharmacists in 3 TMU hospitals
- Second 5-year plan approved and started in 2020









- UIC faculty visiting TMU and affiliated hospitals
- TMU pharmacists came to UIC for clinical education (21 since 2014)
- TMU students came to UIC for summer program on 'Contemporary clinical pharmacy education and practice'


