

- FIP is a vibrant and growing organisation that meets the needs and functions of its members


# **ONE FIP**

We can have no pharmaceutical care without a pharmaceutical workforce, no workforce without education and no pharmaceutical care without a scientific foundation.






# Committing to primary health care




