European Statements of Hospital Pharmacy



Statement 1.7

"Hospital pharmacists must be involved in the design, specification of parameters and evaluation of ICT within the medicines processes. This will ensure that pharmacy services are integrated within the general Information and Communication Technology (ICT) framework of the hospital including electronic health (eHealth) and mobile health (mHealth) procedures."



Fact check: Where are we in European hospitals (pharmacies) in the 20th century?






... mostly analogue

- European Commission Communication on Digital Health and Care
 - Securing data access and sharing; connecting and sharing health data for research;
 strengthening citizen empowerment
- European Al Alliance & Al White Paper
 - Discussing and developing policy options to facilitate a secure and trustworthy development of Al
- European Health Data Space (EHDS)
 - Fostering the exchange, and sharing of different kinds of health data (electronic health records, genomics, registries, etc.)
- EMA/HMA Big Data Steering Group
 - Identifying practical steps for the European medicines regulatory network to make best use of big data
