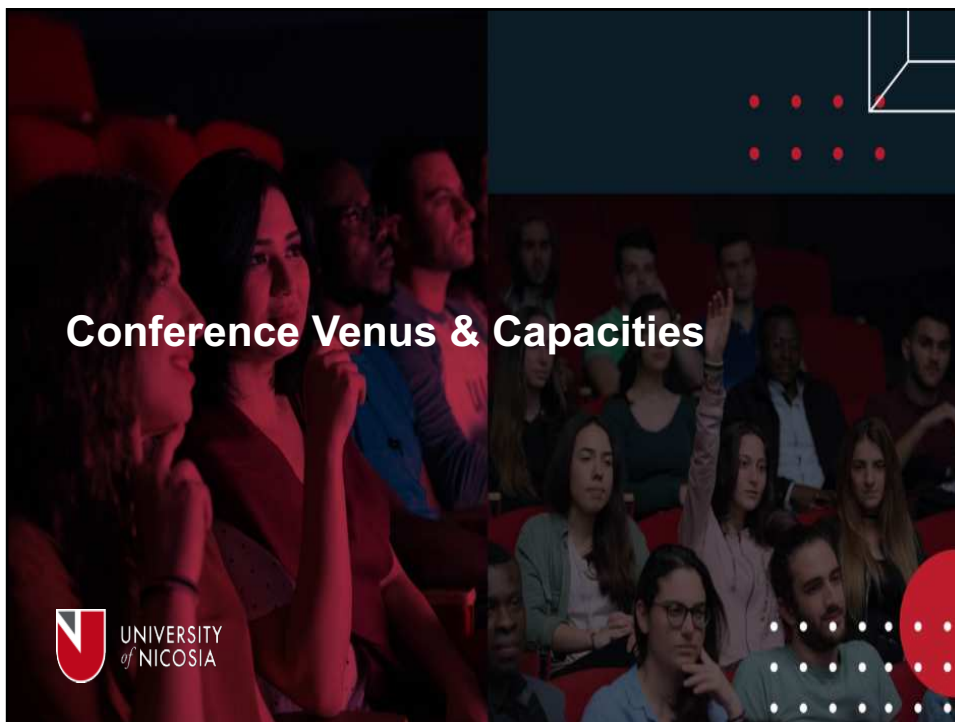

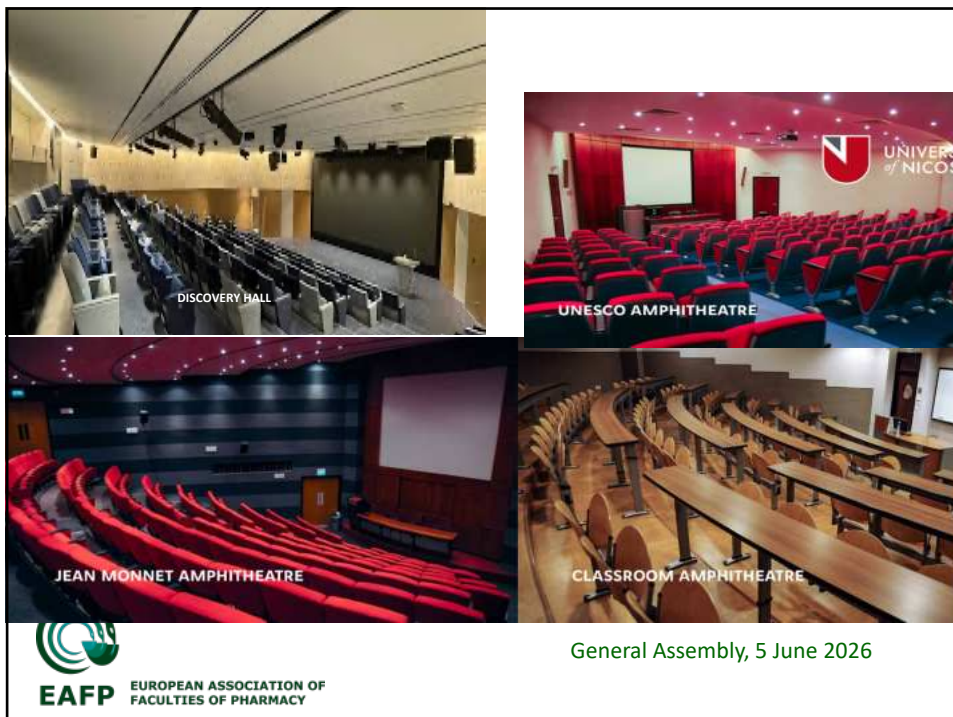

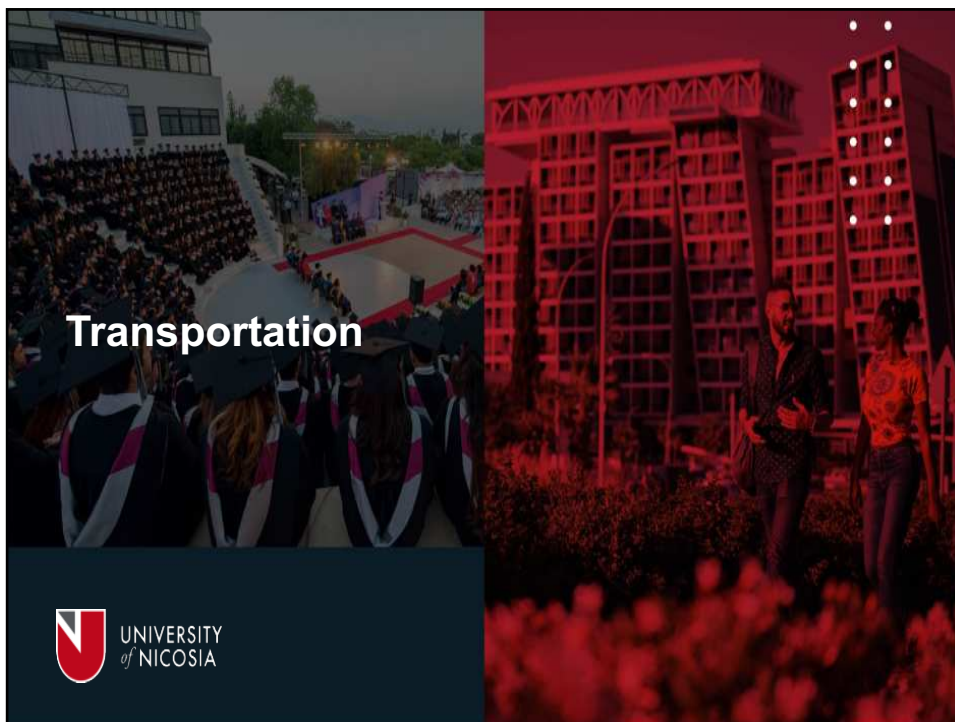

Transport Accessibility

- **Airport Connectivity:** Cyprus connects with Europe through Larnaca and Paphos airports offering numerous direct flights from key cities.
- **LARNACA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT:** Located in Larnaca, 53km south of Nicosia. There are two options to navigate from the airport to Nicosia; either by taxi, or by the Airport Shuttle Bus.
- **PAPHOS INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT:** Located in Paphos, 145km west of Nicosia. There are two options to navigate from the airport to Nicosia: either by taxi, or by the Airport Shuttle Bus.
- **Shuttle Transport Services:** Airport Shuttle Bus provides daily routes from airports to Nicosia, with affordable fares and reasonable travel times.
- **Taxi Options:** Taxi services are available for quick transport to Nicosia from Larnaca Airport, with fares ranging from €70 to €85.
- **Local Public Transportation:** Cyprus Public Transport offers multiple bus routes in Nicosia accessible via the Pame App for convenient local travel.

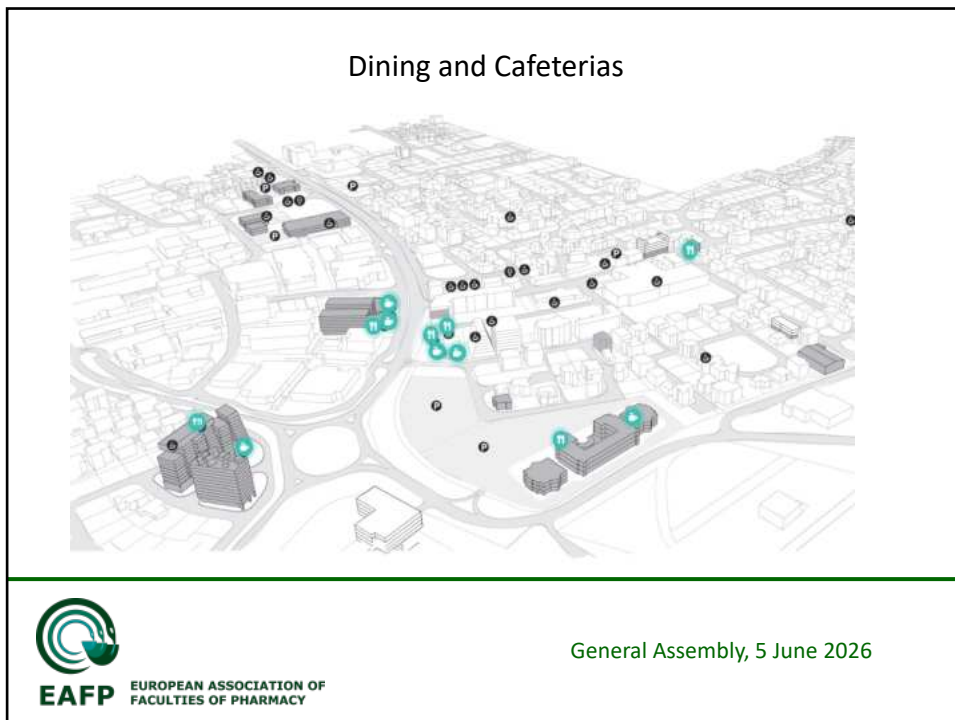

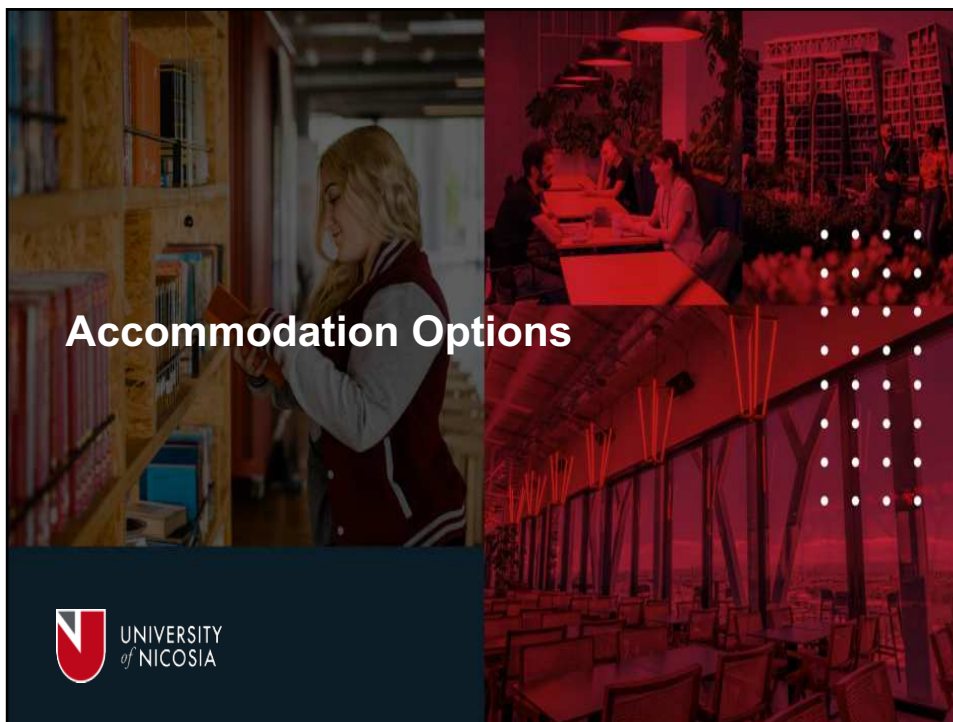

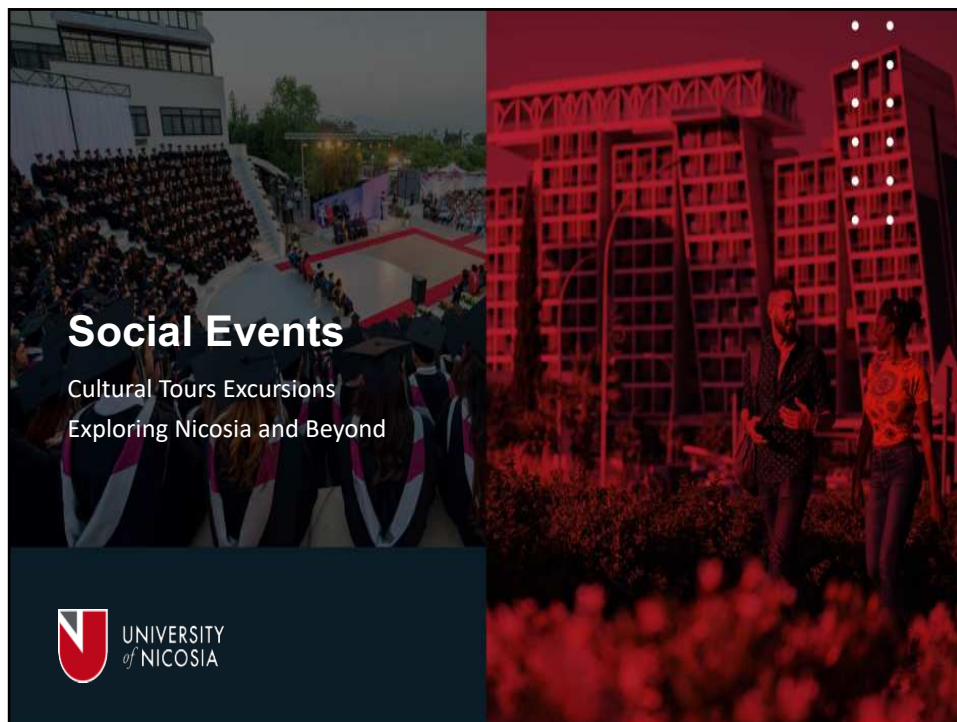
